

# Welcome!

What better day to visit than during the Cooper-Young Festival! On this day, we kick it up a notch with a free, family-friendly arts and crafts street festival teeming with music and food. It's the biggest party of the summer! The Cooper-Young Business Association hosts this annual fundraiser to make the district known locally and nationally and to draw homeowners and merchants into the neighborhood. The proceeds are redistributed into the neighborhood infrastructure, business websites, and community non-profit organizations. Home to over 187 independently owned businesses in Memphis, Cooper Young is home grown, locally led, and community raised.

#### Pre-fest Fun

Each year the Festival is preceded by pre-festival events. The Festival Weekend Kickoff Party, where we will celebrate our 2019 poster artist Mollie Riggs, will be Thursday, September 12 at Epicenter Memphis (902 South Cooper Street). This event is free to the public; please join us for wine and cheese, a beer bar, and music from 6-9 p.m.

Then on Friday, September 13, the Festival 4-Miler is scheduled to begin at Bluff City Sports at 769 South Cooper at 7 p.m. A fundraiser of the nonprofit Cooper-Young Community Association, this event annually draws more than 2,000 competitors for a race that winds through the quaint, tree-lined streets of the neighborhood. And it's not just fun for the runners as residents come out at wild-and-colorful Light the Way parties along the route to spur on the racers. Come cheer on the runners at one of our many patios!

#### **Getting Around**

This year shuttle services and parking are being offered by our partners, Premier Transportation and Christian Brothers University. Park your car in the CBU parking lot entering off Central Avenue and catch the shuttle over to the entrance of the festival. Handicap parking is also available. Shuttle services will run from 9 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

Innovate Memphis Commute Options encourages you to ride your bike and park it in their "Bike Corral" hosted by Bluff City Sports on the right as you enter the festival site at Central Avenue. Volunteers will be on-hand to make sure your bike stays safe and is waiting for you when you get ready to leave. Bikes, scooters, or any type of motorized vehicles are not allowed in the festival site.

#### **Family Fun**

The Cooper-Young Festival is all about unique finds. With 425 vendors at this year's festival, you are bound to find whatever you need or didn't know you needed, from original art works in every medium to jewelry, clothing, pottery, and collectibles. Our vendors also include a number of businesses and local organizations with important community information and, of course, the delicious food and drink vendors.

Be sure to take the kids for some family fun at the Sprouts Farmers Market Kid Zone, located in the parking lot of Epicenter Memphis at 902 Cooper. The kid zone is hosted by volunteers with the Civitians. The area will offer an assortment of hands-on art projects as well as games of chance and prizes. Sprouts Farmers Market will have free healthy goodies and games for all ages. All proceeds from the Sprouts Farmers Market Kid Zone goes toward helping children in our community with developmental disabilities.

Finally, with seventeen musical acts across three stages, Cooper-Young Festival is as much a feast for the ears as it is the eyes and taste buds. This year's headliners include TheShotGunBillys, on the Main Stage near the intersection of Cooper and Young, and Alice Hasen & the Blaze on the Memphis Grizzlies Stage at Young and Meda.

In addition, this year Cooper-Young Festival is a proud to partner with We Are Memphis to present Memphis: A New Century of Soul in celebration of the city's bicentennial. This stage is located in the First Congo Church parking lot and is serving up an outstanding mix of Memphis music, including the Lucky 7 Brass Band, Marcella & Her Lovers, and James & the Ultrasounds!

## CY resident design 2019 festival poster art



The Evolve Bank and Trust Cooper-Young Festival is pleased to announce that local Memphian and Cooper-Young resident Mollie Riggs has been named the 2019 Poster Artist.

Riggs is a native Arkansan who attended Parsons School of Design in New York City before moving to Memphis in 1983. She is a graduate of Memphis College of Art and currently is a self-employed artist with a primary focus in decorative design, which includes faux finishes, murals, and restoration. Her fine art reveals her love of nature and the urban landscape.

Riggs rented a home in Cooper-Young for several years and knew early on that the Cooper-Young Historic District was the neighborhood she wanted to live in long term. In 1995, she purchased a house, already knowing other artists who lived on the street.

"It immediately felt like home," she says.

The three days of Cooper-Young Festival festivities kick on Thursday, September 12 from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. The Festival Kickoff Party, hosted by Epicenter Memphis located at 902 South Cooper, will feature live music, hors d'oeuvres from local restaurants, and beverages. There will also be a silent auction with this year's original poster art by Riggs up for bid. The event will also highlight the talented entrepreneurs who work under the Epicenter umbrella.

#### Obruni Dance Band 11:15 a.m.

Obruni Dance Band is a Memphis band playing dance music that is heavily inspired and influenced by Highlife music from West Africa, and other styles of Afro-pop, including Highlife, Zoblazo, Makossa, Soukous, and Afrobeat. Obruni Dance Band has three main long-term and short-term objectives: 1. To introduce people in the Memphis area to Highlife and Afro-pop dance music. 2. To turn new listeners on to the classic artists that inspire Obruni's music. 3. To let people dance and feel joy!

#### Amber McCain Band 12:15 p.m.

Brighton, TN's The Amber McCain Band formed in late 2014. Lady Antebellum and Fleetwood Mac immediately come to mind when they talk about their top influences. They pride themselves on their versatile range of covers and original tunes that have made quite a buzz around the Memphis music scene. Two of their original songs, "When I Cry" and "In the Delta," have been featured on Rock 103's "Memphis Made" radio program. They shared the stage with country music star Mark Wills at the Osceola Heritage Music Fest in 2017.

#### Mama Honey 1:15 p.m.

Mama Honey was formed in 2018 when Tamar Love, singer/songwriter/guitarist, met David McNinch, drummer, after she posted a call on Facebook for musicians to start a band. They connected over a love for '90s grunge music and began working on original songs. They got the attention of Fields Falcone, bass, when they posted a video of one of those songs. She joined the band soon after. With Tamar's soaring vocals and bluesy guitar, Field's thunderous bass, and David's headbanging drums, Mama Honey's unique blend of punk/blues is a breath of fresh of air in the Memphis scene while also referencing the legendary sounds of Beale St.

#### Seeing Red 2:15 p.m.

Featuring two terrific female vocalists and a song list made for a good time, Seeing Red has become a fan favorite,

selling out the biggest events throughout the Mid-South. Adaptable, energetic, and talented, this band plays a variety of songs, as well as, songs from their EP *Stereotype*,

#### Under the Radar 3:15 p.m.

Under The Radar formed in August of 2014 and played their first show one month later at The Cooper-Young Festival when they were just 10, 11, and 12 years old. The band went on to open for Kansas in April of 2015 and has since opened for Loverboy, .38 Special, Saliva, Better Than Ezra, LA Guns, Nelson, and Bret Michaels. They've released two albums and have garnered airplay all over the world. They won their first Battle of The Bands in October of 2014 at the St. Francis OctoberFest. In May of 2016, they won the Dream Night Talent Search in Dallas. Texas. and in November of that year they won the MySitti Talent Contest in Nashville. In 2018 they won the Up And Coming Artist Duo/Group Award at the Josie Independent Music Awards in Gatlinburg, TN.

#### Fevertree 4:15 p.m.

Fevertree is a Memphis-based rock band that pulls heavily from their South-

ern roots. They put forth a powerful and eclectic mix of Southern rock, blues, funk and Memphis rock-and-roll. The band was formed in 2014 by Tim Dills, John Patterson, Mike Bertoldo, and Kyle Reed. With over 50 years of combined experience in the Memphis music industry scene among its members, Fevertree describes its music as "uniquely blended, finely crafted rockand-roll." The band released their debut album, aptly titled *Lessons Learned*, in January of 2019. The album is composed of soulful, blues-influenced Southern rock and is a true reflection of the band's combined influences.

#### The ShotGunBillys 5:15 p.m.

The ShotGunBillys are all the good sounds Southern music has to offer. They can be found rocking out with Black Oak Arkansas' Jim Dandy just as surely as jamming with The Bar-Kays' James Alexander. The ShotGunBillys hail from the outskirts of Memphis, where they were nurtured on the sounds — blues, soul, and Southern rock — that made Memphis great but have carved a distinct sound that blends it all. Lance McDaniel (lead vocals, guitar), David Snell (backing vocals, bass), and Case Cooper (drums, percussion), all veterans of regional bands, started playing together as the ShotGunBillys in 2008. The 2014 debut album, *BAM!*, garnered them fans and radio airplay. Their song "Sic My Hogs on You," a tribute anthem to Arkansas Razorback tradition and players has more than 20,000 views. Over the past decade the ShotGun-Billys have played across the South, delivering the same double-barrel thrills whether they are playing before one fan in a sleepy Arkansas roadhouse or 15,000 at Daytona Bike Week.

#### MEMPHIS GRIZZLIES STAGE Amy Jamison 12:30 p.m.

Born and raised in Memphis, Amy Jamison is no stranger to the rock-n-roll scene. Her father, Jimi Jamison of the band Survivor, showed her what it takes to be a rising star in the music business. Amy's acoustic sound along with convincing melodies are fresh and heart stopping. She has played with rock masters such as Wally Palmer of the Romantics, John Cafferty, Joe Bouchard of Blue Oyster Cult, and Larry Hoppen of Orleans. Amy has never forgotten her humble beginnings. She has been dedicated to working with charities all over the world. Amy is currently working on her self-titled CD, which is due out this year.

#### Stephen Chopek 1:30 p.m.

Since relocating to Memphis from New Jersey in 2014, Stephen Chopek, a noted drummer who has worked with Charlie Hunter, John Mayer, and Jesse Malin, among others, has embraced many new things, not the least of which is Memphis music scene's sense of spontaneity. The city's damn-the-torpedoes musical attitude informs Chopek's third full-length album, 2018's Begin the Glimmer. Heavily influenced by a steady diet of Guided By Voices, Talking Heads, and The Replacements, Chopek decamped to Cooper-Young's 5 and Dime Recording to make the album, playing every instrument on the album. Begin the Glimmer possesses a rapid-fire, stream-of-thought lyrical style reminiscent of Billy Bragg, and bedrock music that is an amalgam of lighter Superchunk, heavier M.

Ward, and the janglier, less decadent-era The Replacements.

#### Robenx 2:30 p.m.

Marginalized and bullied because of his albinism. Robdarius Brown as a child once considered taking his own life. It was his mother — a source of love and support who encouraged him to channel his pain into music. Robdarius created the alter ego Roben X and, imbued with a newfound self-confidence, transformed himself into an anti-bullying and albinism advocate. Now a young adult, Roben X has taken his fight to global stage with words and music. In 2018, he traveled to Geneva, Switzerland to speak and perform at the United Nations during their Human Rights Day Celebration. He has received special recognition from the Mayor of Memphis for his advocacy work. And he has been applauded as a human right champion by Stand Up for Human Rights. Roben X loves to engage with fans whether it's through words or songs. His music is the place where hip hop and rock meet with infectious beats and meaningful lyrics that make people feel good about who they are.

#### Brother Levee 3:30 p.m.

#### Alice Hasen and the Blaze 4:30 p.m.

Born in Vermont and based in Memphis, Alice Hasen is a professional violinist, recording artist, songwriter, sideman, teacher and vocalist. Hasen, whose mother is a flautist in the Vermont Symphony Orchestra, began her music studies at the age of four. She played in the Vermont Youth Orchestra throughout high school, performing in China and Carnegie Hall and rising to the rank of co-concertmaster. She continued her classical career while studying French and music at Yale University. After graduation, she made a dramatic turn, moving to Clarksdale, Mississippi to teach and shift her her musical focus toward roots music. She leads her original band, Alice Hasen & the Blaze, and is part of the Blackwater Trio, an acoustic rock band. Alice is known for her unique playing style, which combines the virtuosity of her

classical upbringing with the freedom and creativity of improvisation. She is most at home at the crossroads of genre, pushing the traditional sounds of violin and fiddle out of their comfort zones and into the realms of jazz, pop, funk and rock.

#### WE ARE MEMPHIS: A NEW CENTURY OF SOUL STAGE Harlan 12:15 p.m.

The rock band Harlan is the namesake of 21-year-old songwriter Harlan Hutton, whose first creative outlet was as a ballerina for 13 years. Faced with the decision to become a professional dancer, Hutton walked away from dance and, with the gift of a \$100 guitar from her mother, took up music. After a few years playing in the band Melinda, Hutton started Harlan in 2016 as an outlet for her own, intensely personal indie pop songs. Working with drummer Miguel Pilcher, bassist Griffin Rone, and Melinda front man Gabriel Hasty on guitar, the group released a string of EPs leading up to this summer's self-titled full length.

#### Lucky 7 Brass Band 1:15 p.m.

The Lucky 7 Brass Band is a Memphis, TN powerhouse bringing the party to every stage they grace. From the sweet soul sounds of Stax to the hard-hitting beat of Memphis Trap, we bring joy and excitement to every note we play. Come get down with us and experience the magic of the Lucky 7 Brass Band. Comprised of some of the baddest of the bad musicians in Memphis, the Lucky 7 Brass Band has formed a raw, powerful sound that must be seen to believe! Whether soul, rock, rap, or pop, the Lucky 7 Brass Band always brings the party, so come get lucky.

#### Marcella & Her Lovers 2:15 p.m.

The daughter of two-time Grammy-award winning zydeco luminary Terrance Simien, Marcella Simien was practically born on stage. Taj Mahal would sing her happy birthday, and Los Lobos' David Hidalgo might drop by the family's Louisiana home for some gumbo. Despite the fairytale-like upbringing, Simien chose to forge her own pathways in the music





business. She moved to Memphis to attend the prestigious Memphis College of Art and slowly tipped her toes into the city's music scene. Her music today is a dueling hybrid of classic Memphis soul and the freewheeling swagger of New Orleans funk, woven together with the sighing laughter of her ancestors: that Creole accordion. Assembling her group from the cream of the crop of Memphis musicians, Simien's soulful voice smolders like a night star, fondly reminding us of a mysterious past while at once exciting us with the romance of an uncertain future.

#### CMajor 3:15 p.m.

DJ C Major's strong musical sensuality connects with party-goers on a personal level and explains why they crowd the DJ booth at the end of the night looking for a mix CD, an autograph, a photo, or just a moment to be near him. DJ C major knows no boundaries. His ability to read a crowd is unique, as his personal and professional experience over 6 years of playing allows

Following the release of their 2014 debut LP *Bad To Be Here* on Memphis' Madjack Recordsand a pair of 7" releases on Misspent Records, James & The Ultrasounds enjoyed successful tours in the U.S. and Europe. They followed up with the 2018 Madjack release *None of The Above*.
